- The 40th conference of UNESCO adopted the resolution to proclaim 4th March of every year as World Engineering Day for Sustainable Development.
- Supported by **80+** peak engineering organizations and **40+** national institutions.

- Children between the ages of 8 and 15 were assembled from various primary schools in the country to introduce them to engineering and to celebrate the contribution of engineers in achieving the SDG's .
- The day was observed in four regions in the country(Accra,Kumasi,Ho,Tamale).
