Presentation of papers:

Papers will be presented according to the themes of the INTERNATIONAL FORUMS

Summary in no more than 250 words, letter size paper (8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11), vertical layout, and 2.5 margins, will include the following data: forum in which the paper will be presented, title, names and last names of the author (s), underlining the main author. The text will be submitted in word format, single space and Arial 11 sized font. About the main author, reference should be made in the form of footnote, specifying degree, scientific category, teaching category, designation, institution, email address, telephone, and fax.

Soft copy of the full text of the paper will be submitted in a word document, pages duly numbered, with a maximum of 10 pages (maximum size of 1MB). The font to be used is Arial 11, with single line space, and without breaks. Language: Spanish. Graphics, tables, figures, images, and charts should be pasted to the document.

The word document will include information of notes and quotes always at the end of the text (before the bibliography that has been consulted). The document, in a letter sized page (8 ½ x 11), will have margins of 2.5 cm.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> The power point presentation will be submitted at the moment of the registration, taking into account that the modality of FORUMS imply that not all will be able to present their papers, only those who are selected. The rest of the delegates will present their experiences in the theme of the forum related to their paper.

Important dates Summaries will be received until May 10, 2016. Acceptance notification of the papers will be sent on May 15, 2016. Papers will be received until May 30, 2016. Summaries and papers will be published in CD-ROM with ISBN
